

#### **Outstanding Nursery**

The baby and toddler rooms provide the perfect environment in which to gently prepare your child for life in the School and our small classes ensure that he or she receives personal attention at all times. Judged Outstanding in all areas, our well-equipped and comfortable Nursery is a fully integrated part of our School, which gives your child the opportunity to benefit from an extensive range of facilities and specialist teaching, as well as easing transition into School.



#### A broad and balanced education

In Years 1 and 2 the children continue their learning journey accessing a more structured curriculum with their skills, knowledge and understanding further developed across the full range of subjects. Languages, Music, Swimming and PE are taught by specialist teachers. A team of qualified and experienced teaching assistants help teachers in their role. School productions, assemblies and public performances help to develop the children's creativity and imagination, with local visits and trips further afield enriching their learning experience and building their understanding of the world around them. We have an excellent pass rate for children who take entrance exams during Year 2.



#### **Gaining confidence**

As the children approach school age we encourage them to become more independent and self-reliant. They follow a curriculum that includes a focus on early literacy, including phonics, and early maths work. While the emphasis is still very much on learning through play, the children do embark on a more structured programme with Languages, Music, PE and Swimming all forming a part of the weekly timetable.

### Preparing for the next stage of their educational journey

As children progress to Years 3 and 4 they are ready to accept greater challenges and responsibilities. The curriculum becomes even broader and deeper and includes additional languages and performing arts, with all children being taught a musical instrument. With the high teacher to child ratios, their self-esteem and confidence continues to flourish, equipping them fully for the next stage of their educational journey.



Not all children are ready socially, emotionally or academically to move on to larger transition schools at the age of 7 so our small Year 3 and Year 4 classes provide the perfect opportunity for children to increase their self-esteem and confidence in readiness for this next step and to sit entrance exams at the age of 9. At this age most pupils at Polam make more progress in one year than the national average of two years, meaning an extra two years with us can make a huge difference.

### The Wider Curriculum

We aim to educate in the broadest sense, providing our children with a wide range of opportunities to experience new areas of learning. Our focus isn't just on traditional classroom-based education; we offer an extensive range of extra-curricular activities and clubs, much of which is part of the weekly timetable – from ballet to soccer, Mandarin to maths puzzles, bead craft to sketching, tennis to IT and everything in between.

#### **Polam Swim School**


Our team of highly qualified and experienced swimming staff teach the children in small groups on a weekly basis. We also provide one of the town's premier swim schools with a variety of lessons taking place each week, including antenatal, baby and toddler, squad swimming, intensive holiday courses and adult beginners.

#### Wraparound care

Daily extended care is available from 8am to 6pm for 48 weeks of the year. We have an excellent reputation for our friendly and fun holiday clubs which run throughout the year and attract people from all over Bedford. The home from home environment and family atmosphere ensure that children feel safe, secure and at ease, providing them with the confidence to make new friends and try a variety of new activities.

#### **Maintaining Traditions**

As well as educating our children academically, we believe it is equally important to instruct them in good manners and respectful behaviour. At dinner time the children sit at tables laid with cutlery and tablecloths and are guided to use good table manners by their teachers who eat with them. In assembly they say prayers and sing hymns. From our Foundation 2 class upwards, all children are allocated to a school House - Herons, Hawks, Owls and Eagles. Children compete on Sports Day and undertake charity fundraising activities in their respective houses, as well as earning house points in class and around the school for good work and good behaviour. At the end of each academic year at our Achievement Assembly the House Cup is awarded to the winning house and individual awards and achievements are recognised and celebrated across the school.





### Moving on

We believe we give our children the best possible foundation for the future, but the journey doesn't end here. We work closely with parents to help establish the best path forward, advising on which school to apply to and providing you and your child with support every step of the way. We enjoy very strong links with all the independent schools in Bedford and our children attend a number of events and activities throughout the year at each of these schools. We also see a number of children each year moving into the state sector. Whatever their path for the future, our parents are happy in the knowledge that their child has received the best possible start to their educational journey.


#### Come and visit us
