

NURSERY 1-3 YEARS

Children may join our Nursery from the age of 12 months. The baby and toddler rooms, Acorns (12 months to 2 years) and Saplings (2 to 3 years), provide the perfect environment in which to start your child's learning journey.

High pupil/staff ratios enable children to start to take steps towards independence in everything from taking off their own shoes to exploring and learning. A strong key person system ensures that each child receives personal attention, enabling them to flourish and gain in confidence. Our well-equipped and comfortable nursery is a fully integrated part of the School, giving children the opportunity to benefit from the extensive range of facilities and specialist teaching such as music and PE.

Nursery sessions are flexible and can be tailored to your child's individual needs. We provide year round wraparound care from 7.30am until 6pm for those families that require it. In order that children feel settled and happy the minimum amount of sessions we offer is 3. In addition we encourage children to start moving towards full time care by their final term in the Nursery, to help prepare them for their transition to the School.

EARLY YEARS 3-5 YEARS

Our Foundation classes cover the 3 to 5 age range – Foundation 1 (3 to 4 years) and Foundation 2 (4 to 5 years). These all important years provide the building blocks for future learning.

At 3-4 years old our key person system is strong, enabling children to build their confidence whilst still feeling nurtured. The children follow a curriculum that includes a focus on early maths and literacy, as well as phonics. The emphasis is still very much on learning through play.

Our 4-5 year olds continue to learn through their experiences, however their day becomes more structured with literacy and numeracy sessions daily. As the year progresses they extend their reading, writing and mathematical skills.

Underpinning all our learning in Foundation is careful assessment and monitoring of progress. This continues from Nursery and allows staff to extend and scaffold learning. At this stage children embark on a more structured programme with Music, Modern Languages, PE and Swimming all forming part of the weekly timetable.

The statutory framework for the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) provides the guidance and requirements supporting the learning and development of children in our care. "My son has gained so much confidence since he started at Polam – we wish we had started him here earlier. The varied curriculum from a young age keeps him engaged and he is always positive when talking about his day. The difference in him is incredible."

YEARS 1-2 (KEY STAGE 1)

5-7 years

In our Year 1 and 2 classes the children continue their learning journey, accessing a more structured curriculum with their skills, knowledge and understanding further developed across the full range of subjects. 
YEARS 3-4 (KEY STAGE 2)

7-9 years

In Years 3 and 4 pupils enjoy taking on the extra responsibilities that come from being the oldest children in a small school, whilst continuing to grow academically through the broad curriculum provided.

Many children leave Polam at the end of Year 2 having gained places at other independent schools in the town. However Polam's small Year 3 and 4 class is becoming increasingly popular, giving children extra time to prepare for this next step, or for pupils who join the school during these years specifically to access the opportunity of working in a small, nurturing environment.

Not all children are ready socially, emotionally or academically to move on to larger schools at the age of 7 but an extra two years with us can make a huge difference. With high teacher to child ratios, our Key Stage 2 class provides the perfect opportunity for children to increase their self-esteem and confidence in readiness for the next step of their educational journey.

The Wider Curriculum

We aim to educate in the broadest sense, providing our children with a wide range of opportunities to experience new areas of learning. Our focus isn't just on traditional classroom-based education; we offer an extensive range of extra-curricular activities and clubs – from ballet to gym, construction to maths puzzles, tennis to IT and everything in between.

Music & Languages

Music plays a very important role within life at Polam, thanks to our passionate specialist Music teacher, and is incorporated into every aspect of the curriculum, from the baby room all the way through the School.

All children have the opportunity to play percussion, and as they get older, they have an opportunity to learn a musical instrument, including guitar and piano.

Children are introduced to languages at an early age at Polam, with French, Spanish and German all part of the curriculum. The specialist language teacher uses music, rhyme and actions to help children develop their vocabulary, intonation and pronunciation and this not only makes the lessons fun and engaging, but enables children to memorise the words more effectively.





Sport

Sport plays an equally important role at Polam and we have our own dedicated and well-equipped gym, indoor swimming pool and use of local sports fields. Our specialist PE teacher ensures that all children are catered for irrespective of their age, ability or potential. The children benefit from playing in teams, competing and achieving at their own level.

Above all, we believe sport should be fun. We find that all the children enjoy PE and Games lessons in the Sports Hall. Various club activities also take place after school and on Saturdays. Swimming lessons take place throughout the academic year in our indoor pool.

Polam Swim School

Our team of highly qualified and experienced swimming staff teach the children in small groups on a weekly basis. We also provide one of the town's premier swim schools with a variety of lessons taking place each week, including antenatal, baby and toddler, squad swimming, intensive holiday courses and adult beginners.

Some aspects of the curriculum are of outstanding quality, for example the wide range of learning opportunities provided through extra-curricular activities and clubs... Wraparound care

Daily extended care is available from 8am (7:30am term time) to 6pm for 48 weeks of the year. We have an excellent reputation for our friendly and fun holiday clubs which run throughout the year and attract people from all over Bedford. The home from home environment and family atmosphere ensure that children feel safe, secure and at ease, providing them with the confidence to make new friends and try a variety of new activities.

Maintaining Traditions

As well as educating our children academically, we believe it is equally important to instill good manners and respectful behaviour. At dinner time the children sit at tables laid with cutlery and tablecloths. They are guided to use good table manners by their teachers who eat with them. In assembly they say prayers and sing hymns. From our Foundation 2 class upwards, all children are allocated to a school House - Herons, Hawks, Owls and Eagles. Children compete on Sports Day and undertake charity fundraising activities in their respective houses, as well as earning house points in class and around the school for good work and good behaviour. At the end of each academic year at our Leavers Assembly the House Cup is awarded to the winning house and individual awards and achievements are recognised and celebrated across the school.
